#### Section G: Rules and Conditions of Exchange

As a Youth Exchange student sponsored by a Retury dath or district, you must agree to the following rules and conditions of exchange. Violation of any of these rules may result in demind from the program and immediate roum home, at student's expanse. Please note that districts may offer this document or instent additional loss of receded to account for local conditions.

#### Rules and Conditions of Exchange

- You must obey the laws of the host country. If found guilty of violating any law, you can expect no assistance from your sponsors or native country. You must return home at your own expense as soon as released by authorities.

- Do not borrow money. Pay any bills premptly. Ask permission to use the family phone or computer, keep track of sill calls and time on the Internet, and reimburse your bost family each month for the costs you iscur.
- If you are offered an opportunity to go on a trip or attend an event, make sure you understand any costs you must pay and your responsibilities before you go.

#### MORAL AND SEXUAL HARASSMENT

#### It is not

Receiving kisses on the cheek from a male or a female, young or adult (in Belgium everybody kisses everybody!)

Joking about sex in front of many people (Belgian people loves to joke about sex!)

Displaying artistic objects (paintings, sculptures, etc.) showing naked human beings

#### No es

Recibir un beso sobre el cachete de la parte de un hombre o de una mujer, joven o adulto (en Bélgica, todo el mundo se saluda así!)

Contar bromas a carácter sexual en público (a los Belgas les gusta hacer bromas sobre ese sujeto!)

Exponer objetos artísticos (pinturas, esculturas, etc.) mostrando seres humanos desnudos

#### MORAL AND SEXUAL HARASSMENT

#### How to deal with?

When you go out, don't go alone in dangerous places and stay with friends

If you have any doubt, especially in your host family or at school, inform immediately your counselor or district officers

If you feel in danger, leave immediately and go where you feel secure (police, friends, crowded place) and inform immediately a district officer.

It is useful to have always phone numbers of family, counselor, district officers with you.

#### Cómo reacconar?

No vayas solo a lugares peligrosos, Quedate siempre con amigos,

En caso de duda, especialmente en tu familia o en la escuela, informa de inmediato a tu consejero o los responsables del Distrito

If any doubt about some behavior, do not hesitate to ask

- ✓ Any adult you are confident in
- √ Your family (sister, brother)
- ✓ A teacher
- √ YEO / counselor

Child Focus is active in Sexually abused and exploited children. They provide a psychological and legal support to the victims.

Never lie to the Police about moral and sexual harassment. That would lead you to prison and enormous fines.

#### What is Xenophobia?

If people are unpleasant because you are a foreigner you must inform your family and YEO, even if it happens at school.

If your teacher or your family harass you because of your nationality, inform your YEO AND a district officer.

Xenophoby is unlawful in Belgium







